Boys must write on one of the assigned days. The assessments measure academic potential. Your son does not need to prepare for these tests and his primary school performance remains an important indicator of ability.

The entrance assessments, and an interview with a senior member of Staff, are part of the enrolment selection process. These interviews are scheduled separately.
