Sport Assessment Date: Monday 16 AND Tuesday 17 February 2026

Sport Scholarships are awarded to boys in Grade 7 who wish to enter St David's Marist Inanda in Grade 8. In order to be considered for a scholarship, an Application form needs to be submitted, along with the relevant supporting documentation. If an application has previously been submitted, there is no need to resubmit.

Criteria:

- The candidate should have achieved a high level of performance in one of the sports offered by St David's Marist Inanda (district, provincial or national honors), and should be A-team players in their Primary School.
- The candidate should exhibit a high standard of behaviour and sportsmanship at all times.
- The candidate should have a sound academic record.

Scholarship Assessments:

- Candidates will be required to attend the sport assessment on **Monday 16 AND Tuesday 17 February 2026**. A detailed programme will be sent to you prior to the assessment days outlining which sporting codes will be assessed on which days.
- All applications will be assessed by the Scholarship Committee, including the Deputy Head: Extramurals. The decision of this committee is final.

Continuation of scholarships each year is dependent on candidates maintaining a consistently high standard of performance and involvement, a positive contribution to school activities and adherence to the College Code of Conduct.
