It's Inanda Hoops time



The biggest schools basketball tournament in the land is even bigger this year

he 2025 St David's Marist
Inanda Summer Sports Festival
kicked off in blistering heat
on Thursday with 40 under-15 and
under-18 basketball teams playing
their opening preliminary pool
games in the Fasken Inanda Hoops
Challenge Tournament.

The 10 under-12 teams that are participating will get going on Friday.

It's early days yet, but the hosts are looking good in both the U15 and U18 sections. The St David's U18s, who finished 8th at last year's tournament, beat Sacred Heart 53-30 and Pretoria Boys' High 45 35 on Thursday; while

theU15s, who are the defending champions in the section, beat St Peter's 37 22 and Grey High 55-20.

Michael Mount Waldorf School have also been impressive in the U18 section. They had a good, 45-41 win over St John's – last year's runners-up – and they beat Crawford Sandton 42. St John's are also looking good in the U15 division. They beat Redhill and The King's School Linbro Park in their opening encounters.

The pool games continue on Friday, with the cross-pool playoffs commencing on Saturday morning. The semifinals are late on Saturday, with the U15 and U18 finals scheduled for 11.30am and 1pm, respectively, on Sunday.

It's not only about basketball, however. Running concurrently with the basketball, there is an U14 water polo tournament, the Inanda Cup, featuring 12 teams. It's an opportunity for the U14s to show what they have learnt in their first year in the sport,

A U12 T10 cricket tournament, sponsored by Cricket Company, with seven teams participating, is also on the go. These players will be getting their first taste of playing on turf wickets.

Tournament play for the U14s

The under-14 Inanda Cup water polo tournament also got under way on Thursday. There are 12 teams competing, including Clydesdale Water Polo Club from Pretoria and a combined Reddam Helderfontein/Beaulieu side.

The games run from Thursday October 16 to Saturday October 18, with the final scheduled for 1.30pm. These U14 players are at the end of their first full year of water polo and this tournament

gives them an opportunity to show what they have learnt, under tournament conditions, in a full-size pool.

There is still a lot of water polo to be played, but the favourites who are likely to playing for the podium finishes on Saturday are already emerging. Some of Thursday's results were a bit one-sided, with the hosts, St David's Marist Inanda, beating Parktown 15-0, and St Stithians notching up big wins over the Reddam/
