The Rangers rule at the T10

Rivonia Rangers beat Temba Bavuma Tigers to take the title for the 1st time



Rivonia Rangers won the Cricket Company St David's T10 tournament, beating the Temba Bavuma Tigers by 16 runs in the final on Saturday.

Rivonia posted 101/4 in their 10 overs, with Tristan Osborne contributing 60 and Benjamin Pocock 18 not out.

The Tigers fell short of the target, despite a brave 31 off 24 balls from Hamzah Ismail and 17 off seven balls by Mbulelo Mtimkulu. Ethan Naidoo and Freddie Fendick both took two wickets to see Rivonia defend successfully.

Osborne led his side well, he was the top run-scorer with 353, and was named the Player of the Tournament. His team mate, Riccardo Scalora, made 289 runs, with a strike rate of 279 and was the Batsman of the Tournament. The Bowler of the Tournament award went to Matthew Moodley of St Stithians Supermen. He took seven wickets in all,

including 3/3 against Jan Celliers Chiefs.

Montrose Meteors were the bronze medallists. They beat St David's Dynamite by 6 wickets in an exciting playoff game.
