

A double double ton for Waterkloof

The trend of big innings continued on the 1st day of the second round of matches at the St David's Marist Inanda Fasken Time Cricket Festival on Saturday, with two 200s; two 100s and 14 50s being notched up.

Pride of place goes to the two double centurions, both at Hoërskool Waterkloof: AJ de Villiers, who was 217 not out against Noordheuwel, and Juan Swart who got 206. De Villiers put on a display of power hitting and precision placement which saw him go to 200 in 180 balls and hit 35 fours.

Swart was as accurate and powerful. He struck 11 sixes and got to 200 in 158 balls. Together, they put on a partnership of 376 runs and helped their side to 498/2 declared.

That was a hard act to follow, but Jeppe's Ethan van Dyk was also very impressive in getting 166, off 153 balls with 20 fours, against the Lions XI. He saw Jeppe also go past four hundred runs – they declared on 404/5.

Given the flood of runs in all the games, there haven't been many outstanding bowling performances at the festival so far. The best figures on day three came from Zaakir Hanslo of St Stithians, who took 4/24 off 20 overs, with 8 maidens against St Charles; and Kairav Koobair of the hosts, St David's, who took 4/47 against Middleburg.

The other hundred in the 1st innings on Saturday was by Cian Sullivan of King Edward VII School, who was 102 not out overnight against St Andrew's. He helped KES to 194/1, after they bowled St Andrew's out for 205 earlier. KES were the only side to win their first game at the festival and they would have been in with a good chance of making that two out two, if the weather had not intervened on Sunday.



AJ de Villiers of Hoërskool Waterkloof notched up a Fasken record 217 not out against Noordheuwel on Saturday.
