Open Day on Saturday 6 February 2021 from 09h00 to 12h00

The purpose of the Open Day is to give you an insight into what it means to be part of the St David's Marist family. Grade 8, 2022 Entrance Assessments

Tuesday 9 February OR Thursday 11 February OR Thursday 18 February 2021 from 14h00 to 16h30.

- Boys applying for Grade 8 in 2022 must write assessments on one of the assigned days. The assessments measure academic potential.
- Your son does not need to prepare for these tests and his primary school performance remains an important indicator of ability.
- The entrance assessments, and an interview with a member of our Executive, are a part of the enrolment selection process. These interviews are scheduled separately to the Entrance Assessment dates.

We have already received many applications for 2022. We therefore recommend that you make an application as soon as possible should you be considering St David's Marist Inanda as a High School for your son.

Academic Scholarship Examinations – By Invitation only

- **Tuesday 9 March OR Thursday 11 March 2021 - from 14h00 -16h30.**
- Candidates will be selected according to their latest school report and their performance in our Entrance Assessments and will be **invited** to take part in the Academic Scholarship Exams.

Sports Scholarship Assessments

- Applications for Sports Scholarships must be submitted by **Wednesday 10 February 2021.**
- Sports Scholarship Assessments will take place on **Monday 15 AND Tuesday 16 February 2021.**
- Sport Scholarship candidates should have achieved a high level of performance in one of the sports offered by St David's Marist Inanda. (**District - Provincial - National**)

Cultural Scholarship Assessments

- Applications for Cultural Scholarships must be submitted by **Wednesday 10 February 2021.**
- Generally, only exceptionally talented boys will be considered - those playing at a Grade 2 level or above in Music or those who have excelled in Drama.
- Scholarships are assessed on an individual basis. Following the submission of a CV, short-listed candidates will be **invited** to a practical audition.
