#### **Professor Manoj Chiba (Partner: The Strategists)**

Professor Manoj Chiba is a distinguished management professional, data scientist, and academic with more than 15 years of experience across the corporate, non-profit, and higher education sectors. As a current Partner at The Strategists, Principal Consultant and Data Analysis Specialist at ATBMI Advisory, and Faculty Member at the Gordon Institute of Business Science (GIBS), he is recognised for his expertise in data analytics, artificial intelligence, strategy, innovation, and evidence-based decision-making. As a Partner at The Strategist, Professor Chiba consults to more than 65 organisations locally and internationally, with experience across 10 African countries, while also supervising MBA and PhD research and lecturing on predictive analytics, digitisation, and digital business strategy. Professor Chiba is also the former CEO of BioRecord Healthcare Solutions and currently serves on the BioRecord Healthcare Solutions (Pty) Ltd board and the CIRT advisory committee. He is widely respected for combining academic excellence with practical business expertise to help organisations drive sustainable growth, transformation, and innovation. He holds a PhD and MBA from GIBS and an MSc, BSc (Hons), and BSc from Wits University.

#### **Justin Prozesky (Principal: Krutham)**

Justin leads the Impact Capital team at Krutham, a leading research and advisory firm based in Johannesburg, Cape Town and London. He is a finance executive with experience across financial services, consulting and philanthropy. He has designed and implemented catalytic capital structures and supported major foundations in deploying blended finance solutions. His current focus lies in aligning investment vehicles with social and environmental impact goals, and he has worked extensively on fund governance and financial structuring. Before joining Krutham in 2024, Justin spent 16 years with Standard Bank - leading M&A and strategic projects across the continent. He was extensively involved in the group's black ownership initiative – Tutuwa – guiding the programme through its unlock and subsequently establishing its legacy community empowerment foundation. Prior to Standard Bank, Justin worked for PwC in South Africa and the UK. He is a CA (SA) and holds an MPhil degree (specialising in inclusive innovation). His research thesis explored the evolution of the Financial Sector Charter.

#### **Mike Thiel (Executive Headmaster: St David's Marist Inanda)**

Mike joined St David's as Headmaster of the High School in January 2014 and took on the additional role of Executive Headmaster in 2015.
